
Sightings of free-roaming Wild Dogs (Lycaon pictus) in South Africa



The Endangered Wildlife Trust's Carnivore Conservation Programme has been capturing Wild Dog sighting records from outside of protected areas since 1995, in collaboration with partners WildlifeACT, Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife, LEDET, MTPA, NWPB, DENC, Cheetah Outreach, SANParks and reserve managers. These data are recorded with partners through the Wild Dog Advisory Group of South Africa (WAG-SA) and the KwaZulu-Natal Wild Dog Advisory Group (KZNWAG). Please note that absence of data does not mean that there are no Wild Dogs in a locality, only that no records are held in our database.
